You will be working with Community Outreach & Education staff. The job duration is from June 12 to August 25, 2017. Job responsibilities include:

- To be responsible for the creation, implementation and management of the summer camp program, in partnership with a Community Outreach staff member.
- During the camp, to be responsible on a daily basis for staff contact, program quality, and on-site safety
- To ensure policies and procedures are being followed and ensure compliance with all health & safety protocols

Duties:

- To arrive at the shelter in sufficient time to prepare for the day and meet the campers as they arrive
- To take a leadership role in the program
- To ensure the safety of all camp participants
- To deliver program content
- To make the camp experience enjoyable for the campers
- To direct the Leaders in Training (14-17 year old volunteers)
