

Canada Summer Jobs Employment Opportunity Assistant to Registered Veterinary Technicians (RVT)

The Oakville & Milton Humane Society (OMHS) is a Registered Charity which relies on the support of the community to care for, shelter and find loving forever homes for homeless and forgotten pets; to investigate and prosecute animal abuse, cruelty and neglect; bring the unconditional love of a pet to long term care facilities with pet visitation; build a more humane society through humane education and act as a resource to the community in strengthening the human/animal bond.

Position Description

Reporting to the *Manager of Animal Health and Care* you will work alongside the RVTs to assist with the processing and maintaining the health of the animals in our care. You will be involved with interacting with staff / volunteers and the maintenance of records. This is a <u>temporary full-time position</u>, 35 hours per week for 8 weeks. Flexibility to work evening and weekend shifts will be required.

Duties will include:

- Feeding/Cleaning of animals.
- Handling animals to examine, medicate, and prepare for adoption.
- Maintain records in Shelter software program
- Assist to collect lab samples (blood, urine, stool) and perform routine lab tests or prepare to be sent to lab.
- Various other duties as they arise and/or assigned by the Manager.
- You will work in a team and interact with the other departments at the Shelter.

Qualifications:

- Demonstrated good animal handling skills.
- Demonstrated written and oral communication skills.
- Ability to work as part of a team and have a positive attitude.
- Basic understanding of animal welfare issues and our position in the community.
- Demonstrated computer skills for data entry.
- Attendance at a post-secondary educational facility (college or university). Preference given to those in a Veterinary Technician/Technologist program or related area of study.
