



# Kids & Critters Summer Camp

## WHAT TO EXPECT:

### • Animal Interaction

We can't always predict what animals will be at OMHS during camp, but we will make sure you spend time with cats, dogs, small animals and reptiles! Campers will also get to help take care of the animals in our education room (rabbits, rodents, etc.)

### • Games & Crafts

We are fortunate enough to have a park next to the shelter, so we will be spending time outdoors (weather permitting). There will be indoor games and lots of animal-themed crafts every day!

### • Education

Every day, we will be learning something new about the animals that we care for. We also have a number of fun and exciting guest speakers that will be visiting us each week.



## AGE & SPACE REQUIREMENTS:

Campers must be between **6-12 years old**, and attend the camp week designated for their age group. There is no flexibility.

There is a maximum of **12 campers** per week. We are a small shelter, and we will be sharing our camp room with Leaders in Training volunteers, camp staff and animals, so spaces are limited!



## WEEKLY THEMES:

There are 8 weeks of summer camp in total - some weeks are for 6-8 year olds and some weeks are for 9-12 year olds. You can sign your child up for multiple weeks if desired, but please note that some activities will overlap week to week.

## HOURS & LOCATION:

Camp runs from 9:00 am until 3:30 pm. **Drop-off** is between 8:30 - 9:00 am, and **pick-up** is between 3:30 - 4:00 pm.

We do not offer before and after care beyond these hours.

The camp is held at the Oakville & Milton Humane Society. The address is **445 Cornwall Road** in Oakville.

## WAITING LIST:

This program is filled on a first-come first-served basis. However, if registration is available and the camp week you are interested in is full, we can place you on a waiting list for a cancellation.

## COSTS:

The fee for the camp is **\$350** for one week. Fridays are pizza days, so there is an additional cost if your child would like to participate.
