GENERAL INFORMATION:

Our education team here at OMHS uses innovative games, crafts and animal interaction to help children gain a sense of understanding and empathy for all types of animals. We teach children the skills they need to stay safe around animals, both wild and domestic.

P.A. Day themes include:

- Cats and kittens
- Rabbits
- Reptiles
- Small animals
- Birds
- Dogs and puppies



HOURS & LOCATION:

We offer both half- and full-day options. The **half-day** program runs from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm. The **full-day** program runs from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm. At this time, we do not offer before and after care beyond these hours.

P.A. Day programs take place at the Oakville & Milton Humane Society. The address is **445 Cornwall Road** in Oakville.



COST:

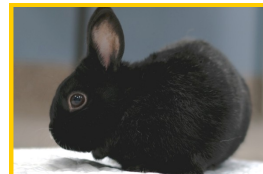
The half-day program is **\$40** and the full-day program is **\$75**. Spots will not be secured without payment.

AGE & GROUP SIZE:

All of our P.A. Days are for **6-8 year olds**.

Due to space constraints, there is a maximum of **10 children** in each session.

Please note that in order for the full-day program to run, we require a minimum of four children to be signed up at least 48 hours prior to the start of the P.A. Day.



DATES:

Our P.A. Day program dates correspond with those outlined in the school year calendar for the Halton District School Board. For a list of specific dates and themes, please refer to our registration forms, or contact us for more information.

ANIMAL INTERACTION:

During P.A. Days, children will have access to child-friendly animals that fit our theme. Attendees will not be volunteering cleaning kennels or interacting with shelter dogs.
