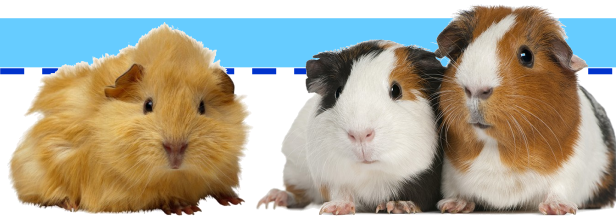


# For Teachers



## GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Oakville & Milton Humane Society offers educational programs for children ages 3-18 in the towns of Oakville and Milton.

## ANIMAL AMBASSADORS:

Typically, an animal ambassador will be present during your visit. These animals are not adoptable shelter pets, but are carefully selected to attend because they are child-friendly.

- Guinea Pig
- Hamster
- Dog

If you do not want an animal to attend, please let us know. In addition, please survey your class and parents before our visit to check for any allergies or phobias.
