Program Overview:

This leadership training program offers teens the chance to interact with the animals in the shelter while advancing their leadership and teamwork skills. LITs will shadow the camp staff and help to educate campers on topics such as proper animal handling, dog bite safety and so much more! The partnership with the Kids & Critters Summer Camp staff allows for constant supervision, direction and feedback, and encourages personal growth!
