We have an opportunity for a Licensing & Animal Control Officer to join our team and work in a fast paced, exciting, and growing organization. This is a Canada Summer Jobs position for a period of 8 weeks, 35 hours per week.

The Licensing & Animal Control Officer is an integral part of the Animal Protective Services (APS) Team. Reporting to the Manager, APS, you will assist the APS Team in the daily duties of an APS Officer, including but not limited to: **Animal Control:**

- Drive transport vehicle to pick up sick, injured, or stray animals (both domestic and wildlife)
- Ensure proper paperwork is completed and recorded on both intake and return runs
- Maintain the vehicle and equipment; ensuring mechanical, sanitary, and safe conditions are met
- Pick up of deceased animals in Oakville
- Garage duties including but not limited to general cleaning, sweeping/mopping, etc.
- Responsible for additional driving duties as required by the shelter: supply pick up, transport of goods between the Thrift Store and shelter, etc.

Licensing:

- Files and retrieves records, documents, and reports within the department
- Follow up on outstanding licenses, issue Compliance Orders as required
- Provides general administrative support as required
- Data entry of license applications
- Other Duties as requested and/or assigned.

This position provides an opportunity for someone who is a highly motivated, enthusiastic team player, who would like the opportunity to grow their skills within an animal welfare environment.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: post-secondary education in a related field
- Valid G license with a clear Drivers Abstract
- Clear Criminal Background Check
- Must be reliable; ability to work evenings and weekends as needed, overtime as required
- Animal handling experience considered an asset
- Ability to lift and move animals or object weighing up to 100lbs
- Proficient in Microsoft Office
- Basic data entry proficiency; attention to detail
