



Volunteer BINGO Ambassadors

Summary:

The OMHS is looking for volunteers to help us with Delta Bingo sessions. Volunteers do not play or run the bingo session. Instead, they are there to represent OMHS and they read out the winning numbers and sometimes help by straightening the chairs or assisting staff. A session is two hours long and we must be represented by 2 volunteers at each session.

There is a lot of training available, and the role is very easy. We simply assist the Delta Bingo staff to identify the bingo winners and sometimes with other small chores. The session times are assigned to us, and we cannot select the times. Our times are often at night.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend all training sessions required
- Following all OMHS protocols
- Respect and maintain confidentiality of OMHS volunteers, partners, and donors
- Reading out the winning Delta Bingo numbers
- Assisting Delta Bingo staff with any housekeeping tasks assigned
- Being kind and courteous to all Delta Bingo patrons and staff

Requirements

- Must be dependable and punctual
- Be courteous and personable when dealing with the public
- Be self-directed, willing to take initiative, and detail-oriented
- Be willing to work as part of a team
- Must complete a criminal background check

Training & Supervision

- Training is virtual and takes about 30 minutes

Time Commitment

- Must commit to a minimum of 6 months in the role
