## WHAT TO EXPECT:

#### Animal Interaction

## **HOURS & LOCATION:**

Camp runs from 9:00 am until 3:30 pm. **Drop-off** is between 8:30 - 9:00 am, and **pick-up** is between 3:30 - 4:00 pm. We do not offer before and after care beyond these hours.

The camp is held at the Oakville & Milton Humane Society. The address is **445 Cornwall Road** in Oakville.

# COSTS:

The fee for the camp is **\$385** for one week. Fridays are pizza days, so there is an additional cost if your child would like to participate.

## AGE & SPACE REQUIREMENTS:

Campers must be between **6-12 years old**, and attend the camp week designated for their age group. There is no flexibility. Each week will have 12 campers.
